Please note that only students taking exams should report to school on 6/17, 6/22-6/25.

In order to maintain the integrity of these State examinations, we will be observing the following rules:

- Uniform Statewide Admissions Deadlines: no student may enter any State examination after the uniform admissions deadline. In addition, no student may hand in his or her test materials and leave the examination room before this time. **The uniform statewide admissions deadline for morning examinations is 10:00 a.m. and the afternoon deadline is 2:00 p.m.**
- Electronic or wireless communications devices are **not permitted** in any of the testing locations. Such devices include, but are not limited to cellular phones, pagers, iPods, smart watches, PDAs and video equipment. Your examination will be invalidated and no score will be calculated for you if you bring any of these devices to the exams.
- Please make sure that your child reports promptly to school for all scheduled examinations. **Students should report to the testing room 15 minutes prior to the start of the exam.**
- No parents or outsiders will be permitted into the building for any reason. In addition, **we are requesting that students not be in school during times they are not scheduled for exams.**

Buses will operate according to the regular school schedule in the morning, ensuring that students arrive at school before their first scheduled examination.
